DM2 UPDATE FROM BRET NAZWORTH

We have come to the end of another year, and the Lord has not yet returned. In light of the world situation, my son David recently said, "We've been given freedom; let's use it while we have it." God has blessed us with freedom and open doors to spread the truth of God's Word throughout the world. If we don't go now, when will we?

We recently finished two workshops in Tennessee hosted by Pleroma Bible Church. We cannot thank God enough for what He accomplished. We have the joy of sharing some testimonies from those workshops in the next two pages of this letter.

DM2 is busy on any given day developing curriculum. This is an ongoing – and vital – process. We recently finished our Panorama of the Life of Christ curriculum as well as a children's curriculum in English and Spanish. These will be available soon.

The pastors and teachers who have been trained by DM2 both here in America, as well as throughout the world, are spreading the Gospel and grace teaching far and wide in an ever increasing manner. Some have small audiences of two or three while others are teaching large gatherings. Last week in Bolivia, four congregations joined together to team-teach Romans 9-16 to a

substantial group of believers. Others are working diligently to make the DM2 curriculum available in prisons. This morning I received word that our curriculum is being translated into Portuguese! We also now have an invitation to go and teach in Brazil.

All of this tends to make our heads whirl. Please pray that the Lord will raise up willing laborers!

On December 1, a team of eight will depart for Bolivia to teach the Panorama of the Life of Christ and introduce our 575-page children's curriculum that Wanda Nazworth has been working on for over 6 years. Pray for the teachers and team members as they present these materials. Pray for open hearts and minds on the part of the attendees.

We are also prayerfully considering another trip to the Middle-East in February to teach Romans 1-8 again. Keep this in your prayers.

Lastly, DM2 is blessed to team with Spokane Bible Church January 24-26 to conduct a Romans 1-8 workshop. The workshop is free and meals will be provided. Discounted hotel rates are available at Quality Inn Oakwood (509-467-4900), mention Spokane Bible Church.

I would like to share with you what I was exposed to at the recent DM2 workshops offered in Tullahoma, TN.

From the outset, the content was a careful and loving verse-by-verse handling of the Christian duty of disciple-maker. The emphasis was on the Great Commission, including Paul's version in 2 Timothy 2:2, *"And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also."*

Being exposed to DM2's ministry paradigm was exciting for me. Their concise handling of the Gospel as well as their teacher-training method made it very clear to me that I could easily and competently participate in world evangelism. Their focus on the propagation of an indigenous local-church organism guarantees that both evangelism and disciple-making will continue to reproduce themselves without DM2's direct participation.

In the study on the book of Romans I was not only reminded what the Gospel is, but also what it isn't. I was surprised to find that after nearly 20 years in Christ, I still had "pet" doctrines and beliefs that could easily

confuse and muddy the biblical Gospel message. The handling of scriptures was simplified for me in the clarification of the three tenses of salvation: justification, sanctification, and glorification. Understanding that justification has to be apart from works, that sanctification happens victoriously after a believer realizes his death to the sin nature, and that glorification is a guaranteed fact, not subject to loss based on the sins of the believer, gave me greater confidence in my Christian life.

I can honestly say that I have never had a clearer, more effective exposure to the subject of discipleship or Romans 1-8. I am thrilled at the prospect of re-teaching the materials in my family, friends, and at future conferences. My prayer is that the Lord will allow me to continue to work with DM2 both locally and abroad, presenting the simplest approach to the Gospel I have ever encountered.

Allow me to encourage you to attend a conference at your earliest convenience. Getting your mind wrapped around this curriculum, its driving principles, and DM2's worldwide vision will invigorate you, as well as provide you with tools you need, to teach the biblical Gospel and build healthy, reproductive disciple-makers.
