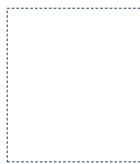

Pastor Clay Ward, John Wry, and I shared the teaching of the Panorama of the Old Testament curriculum. The attendees were greatly blessed by the teaching of truth of God’s Word. BRAD RIGBY:

In a country and culture where truth is suppressed, the truth of the Gospel of Christ, "that He died for my sins and rose again," (1 Cor. 15:3-4) was presented to approximately thirty to forty Sunday school teachers. Our team, led by Bret, taught through Romans 1-5, with nearly twenty hours of teaching. These students braved temperatures of nearly one hundred degrees without air-conditioning to hear the Word of God. They learned that they were justified by grace through faith and not of themselves (Ephesians 2:8-9); nor from works, rituals, or clichés that continue to permeate the Christian world. It was encouraging to see the veil lifted when they finally understood it is Christ's death on the cross and resurrection which saves. Additionally, they were excited to learn this fact because it demanded the obvious conclusion: they had done nothing to earn their salvation; thus, they could do nothing to keep it. They were eternally kept by grace in His saving, omnipotent hand.

In view of disciple-making, the people were challenged to return to their family, friends, and churches to teach the material to others. Many of them said they planned to do just that. Others knew that the place to begin teaching was at home with their families. Please pray for this group of men

and women in their challenge; it will not be an easy task nor will it be without opposition. Let His Word go forth!

We were always in the Lord's protection; David said it best, "The Lord is [our] strength and [our] shield." (Psalm 28:7). We appreciate all of you who joined with us through your financial support and your prayers. If you are able, please support the Middle Eastern ministry of DM2 financially. If not financially, then please support us with your prayers for the team and for these men and women, that they may make disciples. We are planning now to return soon to build upon what God has begun in the lives of the people there. With God's provision, DM2 will return to these gracious and generous people to continue to share the Gospel and teach the doctrines of justification, sanctification and glorification. CRAIG NORTHCOTT:

I did not know what to expect in going to the Middle East. I have never done anything remotely similar to this. I have not traveled internationally or formally taught the Word of God. I was honored that DM2 would allow me to participate in its ministry in this way. It certainly was a humbling experience in many ways and taught me where I need to improve my own learning and understanding of the Bible.

All that said, it was wonderful to see these Middle Eastern people so open to God's Word. They certainly had a lot of baggage that came from their various church backgrounds. It was amazing to see them accept the true salvation message of faith alone in Christ and his work on the cross as shown by Paul in Romans. It was also interesting to see the resistance one received when specifically teaching that salvation is not through works or clichés like, "asking Christ into your heart." Thankfully, as a team we were able to handle this with grace and skill using specific Bible passages. This was a motivation to me to become more adept at this. To be able to watch and learn from my teammate's teaching was a blessing. It was great to observe their ability to relate and interact with the national trainees.

In the end, I believe that God has opened a door in the Middle East. We believe that many were saved through God's use of DM2. I look forward to continuing with God's ministry there so long as He continues to provide the means to do so.

PITTSBORO, NC WORKSHOP

Thanks and praise be to God for providing for the first Spanish DM2 workshop in Pittsboro, NC on August 6, 7, 13.

Pastor Benitez (church-planter and long-time pastor) organized a group of pastors and leaders for this workshop. Carlos Tellez taught verse-by-verse through the DM2 Romans 1-8 curriculum. He covered justification, sanctification, and glorification in Christ, as well as what the Gospel is and is not.

The 20 students who attended were very pleased with the teaching and plan to attend the follow-up workshop on Romans 9-16. Each attendee was equipped with teacher/student e-manuals, PowerPoint presentations, recordings of the teaching, and two books that support the instruction. They are excited to teach the curriculum to others before the next workshop. Here are some quotes from the attendees:

What impacted you the most from the workshop?

"To understand that even without the Bible you can confirm the existence of God. Therefore, even those people who have never heard the Gospel will be judged based on what was revealed to them." O. Marin from Colombia

"...to know that we cannot lose our salvation, to know that we are not saved by our efforts, but by grace and only by having faith we can be saved." Z. Hernandez from Honduras

What changes has the information made in your life?

"...My way of thinking about the Law... the Law only helps us to see our bad (sin), but it is not the solution... the solution is the grace of Jesus Christ." Pastor Ocampo from Mexico

How will you use this teaching to glorify God?

"My plan is to share this workshop with the leaders in my church. In this way they can share it with all the other members through small groups that we already have established." Pastor Ocampo from Mexico

"As a member of my church, I would like to have a study in my home and reach souls for Christ and share the gospel. Also, now I feel more sure about sharing the Word of God in all places." M. Webster from Mexico
