"I learned to see myself where I was: I was lost but now I am saved." - Joel

"Grace and faith were emphasized. I learned one can easily depart from the true gospel to a false gospel. What impacted me most was that grace is not earned; it is a gift from God, who is Jesus Christ." - **Sonia**

God's work in Argentina - Pastor Ismael Pérez

I thank God for brother Carlos Tellez's invitation and help that made it possible for me to be part of this trip once again. And I give infinite thanks to God for His salvation and grace in giving me the great privilege of being His servant.

It was a great joy to return to Argentina this year. We had already taught Romans 1-8 and the DM2 discipleship manual at this church, so this time we taught Galatians. There was good participation. Many young people came with a great desire to study the word of God.

On this trip, we took the challenge of including some of the brothers from the church in the teaching. Since they had been through the gospel section of the curriculum the year before, we asked them if they could come



to the church where we were staying in the morning to review the material with us so they could teach it in the evening meetings. They did more than just come in the morning! We were up till 2am answering their questions and preparing them with many suggestions and examples they could use in their teaching.

Almost all of these were young men. In the evenings when they taught, God's power was evident. At the end, the church not only heartly applauded, but many wiped away tears. They were amazed to see their own young men teach with such passion. The pastor himself was very impressed by how effectively these young inexperienced men taught the word of God. The truth is their messages were as clear as could possibly be. No one could deny the power of God working in them.



Recently, the pastor wrote me that together with this group of young men they are now training others in the church to teach.

Once again, we were made aware that this is God's work and that He is pleased when we trust in His plans and in His method (teaching faithful people to teach others according to 2 Timothy 2:2). Let us pray for this work of God in the church "Christ Lives.

An Unforgettable Experience in Argentina - Pastor Ángel Peña

Leaving from Bolivia with Pastor Ismael Pérez and then meeting Pastor Carlos Tellez in Buenos Aires, Argentina was an unforgettable experience. I will share three things I took away from this missionary trip.

First: I believe I was the one edified by sharing with these servants the wonderful letter to the Galatians. I will always be grateful for this opportunity. Not only did all three of us teachers have the same vision, but we also had the same message of the gospel of the grace of God. Eating together, learning from each other, and transmitting confidence at every moment was beautiful.

Second: The response of the brothers and sisters to the teaching of the word remains in my mind: seeing them arrive punctually and being attentive to all the teaching, both young people, children, and adults; and sharing with us every snack and conversation was amazing. It was marvelous to be able to share with them the gospel, the most wonderful work in the world.

Third: Most importantly, I witnessed faithful men teaching the notes as if they already had experience in teaching. We spent time preparing the brothers who were going to teach in the evenings. Pastor Victor began teaching the notes, then three young people shared the word with the entire church. The church was amazed watching their own young people teach the word of God.



The hospitality and generosity of the church was a simply unforgettable experience. I could spend a lot of time talking about the wonders of our God in the Cristo Vive Church in Argentina, but I wanted to just share this small testimony. It will always be a privilege to share the notes of our dear brother Bret. Thank you, brother, for having the patience to teach me the word of God, and in that way take the message of the gospel to Argentina.
