Here we are at the end of 2022 and DM2 is alive and well.



Our 3D Training Center continues to function amazingly well. This year we have 11 students, 4 staff couples, and 4 interns. Our staff and interns all care deeply about each student and are always available and ready to provide encouragement, counsel, and prayer on an individual basis. Because our staff are supported by churches and individuals, we can keep costs way down for the students.

During the last two weeks of January, Brad Rigby and Bret Nazworth plan to go to Cameroon, a small country on the west coast of Africa bordering Nigeria. Although they will be teaching a small group of 10-20 leaders, this trip is largely exploratory to determine the possibility of future ministry there.

Our fields of Bolivia and Venezuela are moving forward. Despite civil unrest in Bolivia and deep economic and political volatility in Venezuela, God is doing great things through the efforts of local pastors and leaders we have trained. We hope to soon return to Bolivia for one last workshop to graduate those who have studied long and hard with us these past 10+ years.

Grace Community Church in Newnan, GA has taken full responsibility for the field of Liberia. Pastor John Clark plans to continue to head up those efforts directly under his local congregation. Pray for them.
