



Ukraine



In April I had the opportunity to go back to Ukraine with Laura Lindell to be part of two Women of the Word workshops in two different cities: Lviv and Kiev. I am very thankful to have had the chance to help at these workshops hosted by Lviv Bible Church and the Word of God Bible College. It was a wonderful trip and a reminder of how evangelism and disciple making are what God desires from the church. If we are willing, He can use us in this way to share the Gospel and what we have been learning with others in our lives. We all have people in our lives who God desires to reach through us. As a layperson myself, it has been such an encouragement to trust God in this and to encourage others to do the same.

The Women of the Word curriculum surveys different women of the Bible. It also ties in, through these historical examples, many Biblical topics, including the Gospel and walking by faith. One of the things I loved most was hearing how God was using this time for all those who were there. As we discussed, studied, and looked deeper into how God took care of the women in Scripture and their responses of either faith or unbelief, Laura and I could relate. Throughout this trip, we experienced the same loving care and answers to prayer.

In Lviv there were over forty women in attendance. The majority of those who began the week continued throughout each evening from Wednesday until Sunday. We learned that some women had traveled far for this workshop; one of them had traveled all the way from the Hungarian border. After the first few nights, we ran out of books and had to print more! It was





a great time of learning and fellowship. Many expressed interest in using the material to further their own study or to share with others.

In Kiev, we had a three-day conference. On the first night, we had to put chairs in the hallway since we did not have enough space in the room for everyone. There was a lot of interest. We hadn't expected so many questions; it was great to see everyone so invested. We encouraged all who attended to get connected with the Ukrainian teachers to study more. In Kiev, we had four different women who wanted to take the material and use it as a Bible study or church group tool. Some have already started.

The majority of the women who taught at both workshops were Ukrainian women trained at other DM2 workshops. Some had been trained at the Word of God Bible College. One of the teachers in Lviv, Larisa, has already led several women's Bible studies for the past two years using DM2 materials. Those who taught with Laura and me in Lviv were Luda Munko, Larisa Chaplaev, Katya Dmytryshyn, Marina Freja, Marina Munko, Gloria Verhola, and Galina Kosmina. Gloria Verhola translated for us. Those who taught with us in Kiev were Luda Ugrimova, Luda Munko, Maria Kravchenko, Oksana Timoshenko, Oksana Kitaev, Katva Grinyuk. Oksana Timoshenko translated for us. Please keep each one of these women in your prayers.

In all, it was very neat to be a part of what God is doing in Ukraine. I am very grateful for all your prayers, generosity, and support! God used you in those ways to be a huge part of the trip.
